- Next steps








Migrants in WRTA Service Area

- Auditor is responsible for auditing the Financial Statements


 Considering risks of material misstatements in the Financial
 Statements
 - Considering internal controls relevant to Financial Statements
 - Performing tests of year-end balances based on risk assessment
 - Evaluating adequacy of disclosures



- Audit completed September 25, 2023. WRTA's Auditor Roselli, Clark & Associates report the following:
 - O Unmodified (i.e., "clean") opinion. Based on their audit, the financial statements are materially accurate
 - O Unmodified opinion on compliance as related to Authority's "major" federal awards program
 - No significant deficiencies in internal controls have been noted




Budget v Actual






Budget v Actual






Revenue by Source
