

# SERVICE SUMMARY

Fixed-route service is provided to the town of Auburn by three bus routes; Route 27, Route 29, and Route 42. Each route departs from the Central Hub in Worcester with destinations in Auburn; including Auburn Street, Auburn High School, Auburn Mall, Southbridge Street, and Washington Street (Rts. 12/20).

As a member of the WRTA Mobility Management Model, the Auburn Council on Aging (COA) provides paratransit services to meet the needs of seniors aged sixty and over and people with disabilities living within the community. Through the shared-ride van service, passengers are able to enjoy increased independence and an active lifestyle with reliable next-day transportation.
