## SERVICE SUMMARY

Departing from the Union Station Hub, Route 5 spans approximately five miles, connecting downtown Worcester to Broad Meadow Brook, with service provided seven days a week. Riders can access key points of interest, including East Middle School, Perkins Farm Marketplace/Stop & Shop, Roosevelt School, Blithewood Park & Playground, and Mass Audobon's Broad Meadow Brook.
